CHINESE GARDEN

The rejuvenated Chinese Garden is where old meets the new, with familiar cultural landmarks that hold special memories, complemented by new attractions and diverse greenery.

1 GRAND ARCH



While crossing the White Rainbow Bridge, gaze upon this architectural icon that is adorned with intricate carvings and ornate motifs depicting Chinese mythology.

2 EDIBLE GARDEN

Learn about practical, sustainable urban gardening, as you wander through various gardens planted with edible vines, flowers, fragrant herbs, spices and even a miniature fruit forest.



3 10 TWIN PAGODA & CLOUD PAGODA



Spot the striking Cloud Pagoda as this iconic landmark within Chinese Garden stands tall on a hilltop. Then explore the three-storey Twin Pagoda to take in the expansive view of Jurong Lake and catch the beautiful sunset over the waters!

5 6 STONEBOAT & TEA PAVILION

Feel the romance and enjoy views of the Lotus Lake at the picturesque Stoneboat. Then soak in the peaceful atmosphere at the Tea Pavilion that appears to float on water.



7 BAMBOO GROVE AND WATERFALL



Walk through the bamboo grove and experience the interplay of sweet scents from fragrant blooms and wind from the waterfall at the end of the tunnel.

8 BONSAI GARDEN

Admire Suzhou-style architecture and landscaping with a specially selected bonsai collection meticulously curated by trained masters in an indoor gallery and outdoor garden setting.

JAPANESE GARDEN

Featuring floral and aquatic gardens, the rejuvenated Japanese Garden interweaves greenery with waterscapes, showcasing the colours and textures of our tropical flora, with elements of Japanese garden design and landscape.

1 FLORAL GARDEN



Explore four thematic gardens inspired by a traditional Japanese garden, and community plots co-created by students, volunteers and partners.

4 5 GUESTHOUSE & GUEST PAVILION

Check out the Guesthouse with its adjacent Guest Pavilion overlooking a scenic and tranquil reflective pool and teahouse. The Guesthouse can accommodate up to 1,000 people in theatre-style seating and 500 people in round-table seating, ideal for your joyous and memorable occasions.



3 11 SILVER MOON & HARVEST MOON TERRACES



Be enchanted by the sight of a series of cabanas at the Moon Terraces of Japanese and Chinese Gardens, mirroring each other from across the lake. They transform at night, with lanterns that reflect the different phases of the moon.

6 SUNKEN GARDEN

Be surrounded by vertical green walls covered with moss and lush epiphytes such as orchids, aroids, bromeliads and ferns that thrive under an ecosystem of lower temperature and high humidity. Admire a water feature centrepiece inspired by a collapsed limestone cave.



9 WATER LILY GARDEN



Discover Singapore's largest water lily collection here, with over 150 varieties showcased in terraced ponds, including day- and night-blooming varieties as well as the largest and smallest members of the water lily family.

11 BREATHING GALLERY

See how artistry and horticulture blend harmoniously through a variety of terrariums, paludariums, and aquariums, curated within this immersive space.

LAKESIDE GARDEN

Centred around the themes of nature, play and the community, Lakeside Garden offers a variety of spaces and experiences for all to enjoy nature and exciting recreational activities.

1 SKATEPARK @ LAKESIDE GARDEN



Gear up for thrills at Singapore's largest outdoor skate park, the first with a parkour park and bouldering wall amidst a rainforest and lakeside setting.

7 WATER PLAY AT CLUSIA COVE

Kids can learn all about tidal patterns, surface ripples and directional currents at this water play area, while having a splashing good time!

12 FOREST RAMBLE



Calling all adventurers aged 5 to 12! Let your wild side run free in this sprawling 2.3-ha nature playground. Explore 13 exciting stations that are inspired by the natural movements of wildlife that are native to a freshwater swamp forest.

15 THERAPEUTIC GARDEN

This therapeutic garden is the first with a section dedicated to children with special needs, and another that caters to seniors and people with dementia. Both sections are wheelchair-accessible.



24 GRASSLANDS



Immerse yourself in a field of tall swaying grasses or head to the bird hides to observe birds that take shelter and feed within the grasslands. Capture Instagram-worthy moments with the Lone Tree or atop the grass mounds.

As no lighting is provided in this nature area, please do not enter after dark.

25 RASAU WALK

Stroll down this meandering boardwalk along the water's edge for a scenic view of Jurong Lake and spot the diverse plant life in this restored freshwater habitat.
